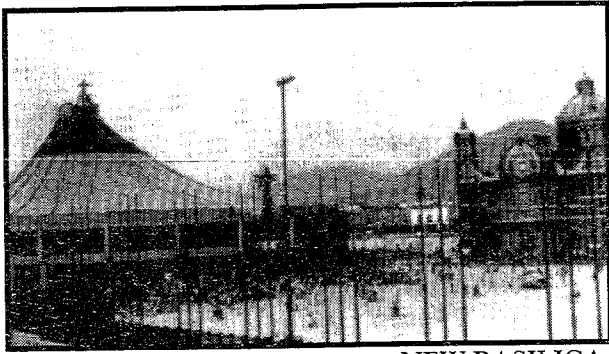
OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE

The Miracle of the Hill

The **GUADALUPE SHRINE** is considered to be holiest place in the Western Hemisphere. Indeed it is venerated to such an extent that United States President John F. Kennedy and French President Charles DeGaulle both took time out during state visits to Mexico to worship at the Shrine. Here Pope John Paul II preached to the faithful millions during his unprecedented 1979 visit to Mexico.

On May 6, 1990, Pope John Paul II celebrated the solemn Mass of beatification of Juan Diego. In his homily for the event, he challenged us to follow Juan Diego's example: to dedicate ourselves in evangelization, works of mercy, and the pursuit of justice for all. What the Holy Father said to the people of Mexico applies as well to us.

Our Lady of Guadalupe appeared on the feast of her Immaculate Conception to which the United States is consecrated. Her five Mexican "visitations", 1,500 years after the resurrection of her Son, three centuries before Lourdes and the Miraculous Medal, and 450 years before Medjugorje, represent the first major Marian apparitions. In many ways, they inaugurated this period of history into which she has been sent to battle Satan, preparing us for the return of Jesus Christ.

During these five apparitions, Our Lady . . .

- confirmed the faithful's belief in her Immaculate Conception
- affirmed the Church's teaching concerning her motherhood of God, her Perpetual Virginity, and her role as intercessor and help of Christians.
- asked for a place of worship to be established which would become a great center for pilgrimages, renewal, and healing.
- promised a sign.

The first papal crowning of our Lady of Guadalupe was in 1895 under Pope Leo XIII. He himself wrote a poem for the occasion. Altogether 24 popes have in some official way honored Our Lady of Guadalupe. Pope Paul VI sent her the Golden Rose. On October 12, 1945, a broadcast by Pius XII proclaimed Mary, Empress of the Americas.
